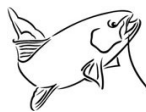

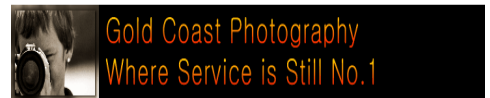

# Winter Open Broadwater FISHING TOURNAMENT

Saturday  22nd August 2009

## Rules

- Fishing only permitted between Jumpinpin and the Gold Coast Seaway, **Broadwater only.**
  - Start time - 5am 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2009, Finishes 3.30pm same day
  - Junior age limit is 15 years and under on the day of competition.
    - All bait types are permitted.
    - **NO Sharks, Eels, Catfish or Rays.**

### 1. Interpretation

- Interpretation of these rules will be left exclusively to the Tournament Director. Decisions of the Tournament Director are final in all matters and not subject to appeal.

### 2. Participation

- Participants under the age of 16 must have the signature of their parent or legal guardian in the provided space on the entry form.
- A completed entry form and entry fee must be received no later than **August 14<sup>th</sup> 2009**. Late entries will be accepted but may not receive tournament t-shirt.
- Entry fees and accommodation packages may only be refunded if notification is received 2 weeks prior to tournament day.

### 3. Sportsmanship

- All competitors are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy and conservation, and to conduct themselves in a manner that will be a credit to themselves, to tournament sponsors, the sport of fishing and the tournaments efforts to promote the sport.
- Any words, conduct or actions reflecting unfavourably upon the sport and efforts to promote safety, sportsmanship, fair competition and compliance with tournament rules are grounds for disqualification.

### 4. Registration

- It is mandatory that each competitor must register in person during the official registration hours, 6pm – 9pm the night before the tournament (Resort guests only) or from 4.30 am on the day of the tournament, at the tournament venue. Any competitor that misses registration will be ineligible to compete, will forfeit their entry fee and will not be entered in the tournament.

### 5. Safety

- Safe Boating must be observed at all times and any speed restrictions adhered to.
- At the discretion of the Tournament Director, Tournament day may be shortened or cancelled due to unsafe weather or water conditions. **There are NO REFUNDS upon cancellation due to unsafe weather.**
- All competitors are requested to proceed to their fishing spots with due care and attention to the safety of themselves, other competing boats and the general public.

### 6. Insurance & Liability

- It is the sole responsibility of the boat owner to carry adequate insurance covering them and their passengers.
- **All contestants are required to sign a waiver** absolving the tournament sponsors, so-sponsors, and their employees from any responsibility for any damage or personal injury sustained as a result of their participation in the tournament or related activities.

## 7. Licenses & Registration

- Boat owners must have current, valid registration for their boats in order to be eligible to fish the event. Penalty for this offence is disqualification.

## 8. Permitted fishing methods

- By rod or handline only
- All legal bait types are allowed
- No net fishing or set line/long line fishing permitted
- Any competitor may use only one line at a time. A snagged lure which is still attached to the rod, pick up another rod and begin casting constitutes using two rods.
- Any breach can result in disqualification

## 9. Permitted fishing locations

- Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters accessible by boat, except:
  - areas designated as "off limits" or "no fishing" by local, state or National Governments and Tournament officials;
  - within any marina;
  - within 25 metres of a competitors boat which was first anchored.
- All angling must be conducted from the boat. At no time may a contestant leave the boat to land a fish or to make the boat more accessible to fishing waters. The boat must remain in the tournament waters during the tournament day. Contestants must leave and return to the official checkpoint by boat.

## 10. Emergency

- In the event of equipment failure or emergency, the skipper is required to contact the Tournament Director via a supplied Mobile number. The Tournament Director will then assess and decide on the appropriate course of action. Couran Point will have Marshall boats, which the Tournament Director may at his discretion, despatch to render assistance.

## 11. Weigh-in's

- Competitors are to present their catch to the Weigh master by the conclusion of the days fishing.
- Weigh in time from 12.30pm
- **Competitors must be back at the marina no later than 3.45 pm.**
- Under sized fish will be disqualified.
- Live catch and release is encouraged.
- Live tank provided on the jetty.

## 12. Late penalty

- If you arrive to the dock after designated finish/arrival time you will be disqualified from the tournament. **Finish time 3.30pm 22/8/09. Back on dock no later than 3.45pm same day.**

## 13. Co-operation with Media/Promotion

- Participation in the tournament grants **Couran Point Island Beach Resort** the use of any pictures or film of contestants, accounts, or interviews with contestants it gathers for the lawful promotion of this tournament.
